SUMMARY/OBJECTIVE

Sealaska Heritage Institute is seeking individuals to work with SHI in developing multiple grants. The grant writer will work collaboratively with the SHI staff to develop strong logic models, grounded in research with strong evaluation questions that support the grant outcomes.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. The contractor shall work with staff to interpret guidelines and gather materials and information necessary to develop a strong grant application.
- 2. The contractor shall write necessary documents for grant application, this may include logic model, abstract, narrative, work plan, budget narrative, etc.
- 3. The contractor will work with SHI DRAFT budget to ensure all items are accounted in budget. The contractor will include needed edits to budget line items.
- 4. The contractor shall draft MOAs. that may be identified by the client and required for the project
- 5. The contractor shall ensure all accompanying documents are in file for grant submission. SHI staff will need to gather documents for contractor- resumes, job descriptions, meeting minutes, etc.
- 6. The contractor shall attend meetings through virtually as necessary to accomplish work.
- 7. The contractor shall provide the research and statistics to support grant proposal.

- -excellent written skills, attention to details
- -prior experience with successful grant applications
- -ability to synthesize information into written format
- -technical skills needed work with SHI virtually
