OVERVIEW OF TASK/WORK

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) is seeking individuals to serve as Tlingit, Haida, or Tsimshian language instructors to provide language support during the Voices on the Land 4th/5th Grade Artist in Residencies, Spring Break camp, and Summer Intensive camps.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Provide Tlingit, Haida, or Tsimshian language instruction in person or via Zoom during the 4th/5th grade school residencies, Spring Break camp, and/or Summer Intensive camp.
2. Provide historical cultural knowledge.
3. Work with teaching assistants to mentor and guide student work.
4. Participate in daily check-ins with staff and prepare lesson for the next day of instruction.
5. Provide responses to surveys or during debriefs.

REQUIRED SKILLS

- Expertise in Indigenous languages and cultures, specific to Southeast Alaska communities.
- Experience working with others in a sharing/teaching capacity.
- Experience in primary and secondary education.
- Demonstrated effective verbal and interpersonal communication skills.

PROJECT/CONTRACTOR TIMELINE

The selected Language Instructor is expected to commit to the Project until July of 2025. This contract should begin as soon as possible and be completed no later than September 30, 2025.
