OVERVIEW OF TASK/WORK

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) is seeking individuals to serve as Camp Teaching Assistants for the Atnané High School Day Camp. The Camp Teaching Assistant will assist the Camp Instructors in planning and teaching daily lessons and activities.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. Teacher assist one NWC Art Class from 9:00 am 4:00 pm, Monday-Friday, with 10-12 High School Students.
- 2. Participate in required pre-camp meetings/trainings.
- 3. Act as a positive role model for students during the camp and support positive participation in daytime academy activities.
- 4. Make decisions and judgements to support the safety, wellbeing and success of students with assistance from SHI staff
- 5. Assist Instructors with implementing the design of the NWC Formline or Metal Class.
- 6. Assist students working toward completing projects and encourage student learning.
- 7. Assist in the preparation of the classroom and supplies needed to teach.
- 8. Help prepare supplies and set up the classroom for each class.
- 9. Ensure that students sign in at the start of each class and that no class supplies are taken home.
- 10. Have students clean up the classroom space at the end of each session and leave the room in the same condition they found it in.
- 11. Assist in facilitating the student showcase for the last day of camp for the June First

Friday art event.

- Serve as a positive role model for youth
- Strive for mutual respect while being an effective communicator
- Build self-esteem and motivation to relate with youth
