OVERVIEW OF TASK/WORK

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) seeks an experienced contractor to support collaborative efforts with Tlingit & Haida's Wellness Program on the development and implementation of Indigenous summer athletics programming. This contract includes content review for a Traditional Games Manual and preparation of program-specific materials for summer/fall 2025 events. The contractor will provide independent consulting services and deliver defined products to support program planning, cultural alignment, and training documentation.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. Traditional Games Manual Review: Provide technical review and written feedback on draft versions of the Traditional Games Manual.
- 2. Traditional Games Technical Documents Development: Develop three finalized Technical Packages, including event formats, rules, scoring, and safety guidelines.
- 3. Event Support Summaries: Submit pre-event coordination plans and post-event summaries that include a logistics overview, key coordination needs, and a summary of outcomes and recommendations
- 4. Draft proposals related to NYO.
- 5. .Updated Coach Training Materials.
- 6.. NYO Rural Program Preparation Packet: Create a preparation packet for summer NYO activities in rural Southeast communities

REQUIRED SKILLS

- Deep knowledge of Indigenous athletics, including NYO and Traditional Games
- Demonstrated experience in technical writing, curriculum or guide development
- Strong understanding of Indigenous values, education systems, and community programming
- Ability to work independently and meet deadlines with minimal supervision
- Previous experience coordinating or advising on regional cultural or athletics programs is strongly preferred
