- Concept Development & Storyboarding: Develop the visual concept and storyboard to showcase the athleticism and cultural significance.
- Script Collaboration: Help develop and refine the narration. The video should feature action footage supported by voiceover.
- Filming: Capture dynamic NYO Games and relevant visuals (landscapes, community, traditional elements, etc.)
- Post Production Editing: Produce a polished 2-4 minute video with professional narration, supporting music, branding and text overlays.
- File Delivery: Provide both high-resolution and compressed versions of the final video, plus raw footage.
- Review & Revisions: Include up to two rounds of revisions.
