OVERVIEW OF TASK/WORK

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) is seeking an individual to assist educators in implementing the culturally responsive work readiness curriculum by providing mentorship and course content support. The ideal candidate should have experience in classroom instruction. Experience in working with families is beneficial, as this course will be delivered in a hybrid format.

This position also involves the opportunity to work with high school seniors as they create their post-graduation plans. The selected contractor will receive training in the college and career guidance and support framework. Previous one-on-one mentoring experience is required.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. Classroom instruction and mentoring experience. A background in mentoring educators and engaging students in a classroom setting to ensure content connects and engages with student learning.
- 2. College and career advising support. Experience working one-on-one with students. This position will specifically require working with high school students using a career guidance framework and infusing this model with SHI's core cultural values and the work readiness curriculum.
