Summer Virtual Camp – (Two Weeks – July 6-17, 2026) Summer In Person Camp – Juneau, AK (Two Weeks – July 20-31, 2026)

SCOPE OF WORK

Before Camp

- 1. Attends pre-camp planning meetings when available.
- 2. Collaborates with Camp Director and Instructional Team to plan arts curriculum based on culture, language, and literacy during pre-camp meetings.

During Camp

- 1. Collaborates with the instructional team to integrate cultural and language activities into the camp curriculum
- 2. Provide Tlingit, Haida, or Tsimshian language instruction in person or via Zoom during Spring Break camp, and/or Summer camp.
- 3. Provide historical cultural knowledge and expertise.
- 4. Participate in daily check-ins with staff to debrief and prepare lesson for the next day of instruction.
- 5. Models and teaches cultural values.

6. Supports Instructors in implementing showcase event.

After camp

5. Participates on post camp meeting or surveys and offers feedback.
