OVERVIEW OF TASK/WORK

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) is seeking individuals to serve as Camp Assistant Instructors for the Voices on the Land Spring Break/Summer Camps. The Camp Assistant Instructor will assist the Camp Instructor in planning and teaching daily lessons and activities. Individuals are eligible to assist with one or more of the following camps:

Spring Break Camp – Ketchikan, AK (March 16-20, 2026) Spring Break Camp – Juneau, AK (March 23-27, 2026)

Summer Virtual Camp – (Two Weeks – July 6-17, 2026) Summer In Person Camp – Juneau, AK (Two Weeks – July 20-31, 2026))

SCOPE OF WORK

Prior to Camp:

- 1. Collaborates with Instructional Team to plan curriculum, based on culture, language and literacy, during pre-camp meetings.
- 2. Attends Pre-camp planning meetings either monthly or biweekly
- 3. Participates in a pre-camp orientation meeting and set-up at the designated site.

During Camp:

- 1. Collaborates with Instructors to implement planned daily activities and lessons.
- 2. Provides students with clear expectations, supervision and support.
- 3. Participates in daily check ins to debrief, address student needs and prepare for the next day.
- 4. Supports Instructors in implementing showcase event.

After Camp:

- 1. Work together to breakdown camp and cleanup.
- 2. Participates in a post-camp meeting and offers feedback

REQUIRED SKILLS

- -Demonstrated effective verbal and interpersonal communication skills.
- -Proficient in computer applications, including word processors, virtual meeting spaces, and collaborative document platforms.
