OVERVIEW OF TASK/WORK

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) is seeking individuals to serve as Baby Raven Roving Readers to support early learning centers in Juneau. This position will work with SHI staff, teachers in a mentorship program and their mentor to schedule monthly visits to read a book and facilitate an activity with the students. The Baby Raven Roving Reader will also be paired with an Elder from their community at each site visit.

SCOPE OF WORK

- 1. Coordinate with SHI Staff about activity supplies and instruction.
- 2. Build relationship with teachers and their mentor.
- 3. Visit multiple early learning centers each month for seven months.
- 4. Become familiar with books and paired activities.

REQUIRED SKILLS

- Ability to work with young children.
- Excellent book reading and storytelling skills.
- Ability to work well within a team.
