## HISTORY OF CELEBRATION

In 1982, the fledgling Native nonprofit Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) held a dance-and-culture festival to celebrate the Tlingit, Haida, and Tsimshian cultures of Southeast Alaska. A couple of hundred Native people gathered in Juneau for the event, called Celebration. Only a handful of children were there, and people were worried that the cultures would not survive.

They could not have imagined then that Celebration would spark a movement across the region—a renaissance of Native culture that prompted people unfamiliar with their heritage to learn their ancestral songs and dances and to make regalia for future Celebrations.

Today, this biennial festival of Tlingit, Haida, and Tsimshian cultures is one of the largest gatherings in the state of Alaska. The event, funded through donations and grants, draws more than 5,000 people, including more than 2,000 dancers from Southeast Alaska and beyond. Thousands more watch the event online. A 2012 study showed each Celebration generates an estimated economic impact of \$2,200,000. SHI sponsors a live broadcast on statewide TV and a live webcast streamed worldwide.

Sealaska has been the major sponsor of Celebration since its inception and is a core contributor to SHI.

## ABOUT SEALASKA HERITAGE

SHI was founded in 1980 by Sealaska Corporation after being conceived by clan leaders, traditional scholars, and Elders at the first Sealaska Elders Conference. During that meeting, the Elders likened Native culture to a blanket. They told the new leaders that their hands were growing weary of holding onto the metaphorical blanket, this “container of wisdom.” They said they were transferring this responsibility to Sealaska, the regional Native corporation serving Southeast Alaska.

In response, Sealaska founded Sealaska Heritage to operate cultural and educational programs. The late George Davis (Kichnáalx—Lk’aanaaw) of Angoon spoke these words:

“We don’t want what you did here to only echo in the air, how our grandfathers used to do things... Yes. You have unwrapped it for us. That is why we will open again this container of wisdom left in our care.”

Since then, SHI has been a leader in language documentation and operates art and education programming across the region, in Anchorage, and the Lower 48.

The nonprofit is headquartered in Juneau’s Walter Soboleff Building, which SHI opened in 2015. The institute also offers programming through its Atnané Hít (Sealaska Heritage Arts Campus) and its Indigenous Science Building.

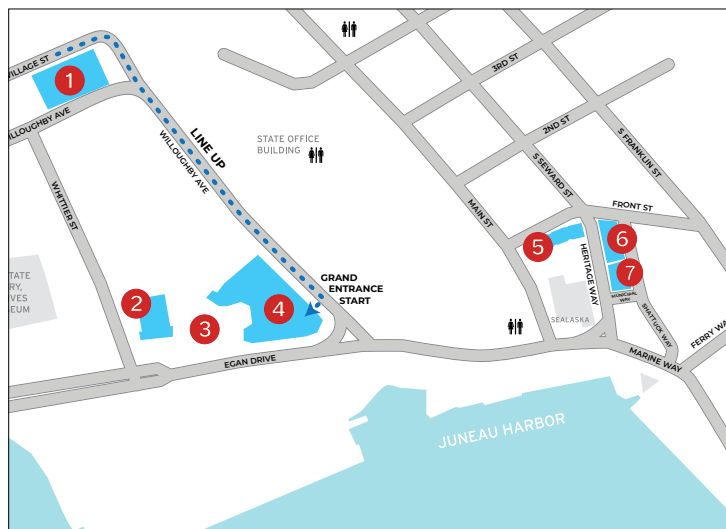

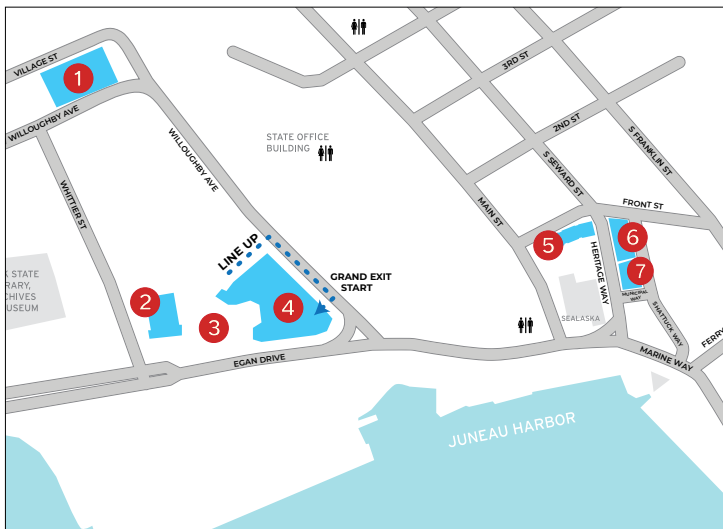

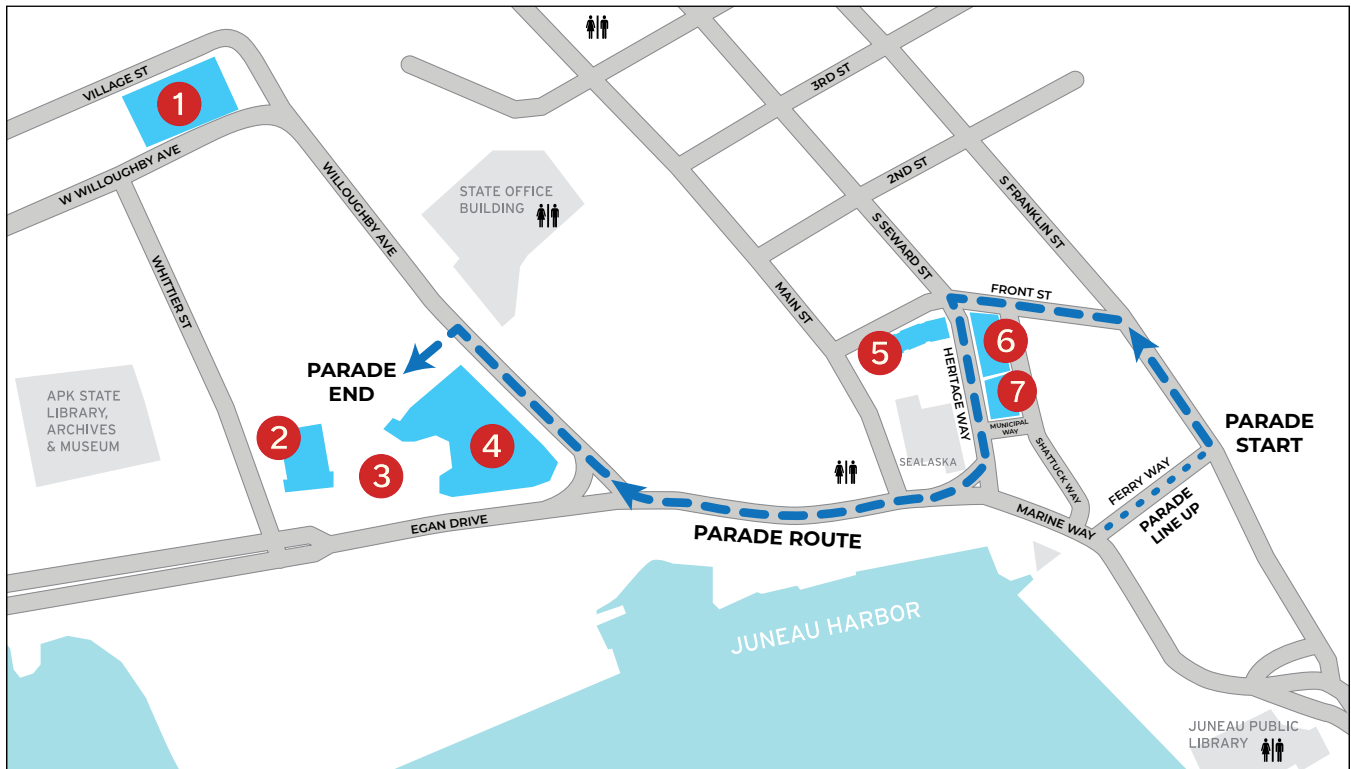

# CELEBRATION 2026 ART

Bill Pfeifer Jr. (Wéidaaká Yóodóohaa) is the winner of Sealaska Heritage Institute's art contest for Celebration 2026. His piece, "Endurance and Strength: The Power of the Clan House," was inspired by the Celebration 2026 theme, Enduring Strength.

Pfeifer said his design is a testament to the stewardship Native communities show each other and the land, which in turn empowers both the people and the place they call home.

"The Tlingit peoples' strength comes from the matrilineal clan structure embedded into our culture," Pfeifer said. "It has allowed us to endure through numerous different pressures. It's because we can lean on each other and learn from each other that allowed us to be so strong as a people in that regard."

His design features a clan house as the island's foundation. A protruding tongue, which serves as the entrance, symbolizes the passing of wisdom and the importance of going home to a clan. On either side of the clan house, red hands extend to the earth and water, feeling the pulse of both the land and the sea.

"This reflects a two-way relationship of care: We support the trees and the mountains, and in return, they support us," Pfeifer wrote in his design submission.

An orca swims just below the water's surface, further embodying core Tlingit values. Orcas, too, belong to family units headed by a matriarch – in Pfeifer's design, the animal is swimming away from the clan house, representing the Tlingit spirit of exploration.

"While the clan house is our grounding, the ocean is our opportunity," Pfeifer said. "We depend on our lineage to sustain each of us as individuals, even as we go out and adventure."

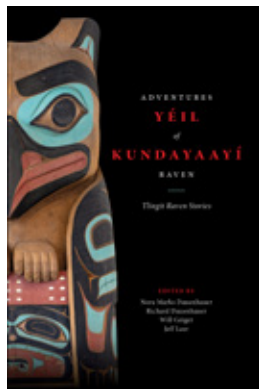

# SEALASKA'S GOALS IN ACTION

Sealaska moves with purpose grounded in who we are. That purpose feels especially near as we gather to share stories, dance, food, art, and song, traditions that bind us to one another and awaken an ancestral echo deep within our bones.

Guided by this inheritance, Sealaska's Board of Directors set priorities that shape how we care for our land, carry our culture and build for our People. This work lives in our communities and in our shareholders who carry it forward each day, strengthened through alignment with partners like Sealaska Heritage Institute. The stories that follow offer a glimpse of that work in motion.



## 1 Recognize Indigenous Sovereignty and Stewardship



Sealaska shareholder and artist Nicholas Galanin Yéil Ya-Tseen is carving a Kiks.ádi kootéeyaa (totem pole) alongside fellow Tlingit artists and shareholders Will Burkhart Kaanáawoollein, and apprentices JR Lindstrom Kéet daaklee.it'ch and Jennifer Younger Káakaxaawulga. Nicholas' children all have contributed, including his seven-year-old. For Nicholas, this is Indigenous sovereignty in practice. Sovereignty lives in language, subsistence, and art and in the relationships that connect people to land and to one another.

The cedar comes from Sealaska's Carving & Bark Program, through which trees are carefully selected on Prince of Wales Island to ensure these practices endure, creating space for shareholders to share and carry forward their gifts.

## 2 Celebrate and Strengthen Cultural Identity to Place



In Sheet'ká, X'aaká Hít, the Point House of the Kiks.ádi clan, once stood as a center of life. Shareholder Lduteen Jerrick Hope-Lang leads the Point House reconstruction with intention. Through this work, he reestablishes a space where identity is grounded and carried forward. Sealaska supports this effort through investment in community-led cultural revitalization. Each beam reconnects youth to lineage. Each step affirms that our culture lives in the present and continues through those, like Lduteen, who show up to carry it forward. Its absence left a void. Its return restores balance.





### 3 Amplify Shareholder Strengths and Leadership

At Sealaska we value building our People up and creating opportunities for leadership. One of the ways we do that is through our internship program. This summer, we welcome 36 domestic interns and five international fellows, the largest cohort yet. We are so excited to welcome our growing leaders, and look forward to sharing their journeys with you.

### 4 Create Sustainable Native Economies in Sealaska's Homelands



Our work aims to create revenue and opportunity for our shareholders. We are truly proud to highlight Generations Southeast, a community center in Heenya Kwaan Klawock that trains people for work that exists in their communities. This approach counters outmigration and supports return while strengthening community. Sealaska is a proud partner in Generations Southeast as they continue to build dormitories for student housing and we look forward to seeing more of our People utilizing these opportunities.



### 5 Cultivate Effective Leadership to Deliver Mission-Driven Outcomes

At Sealaska headquarters, 40 percent of employees are shareholders, reflecting a commitment to building leadership from within our community. That pathway continues to grow. Three interns from last summer stepped into full-time roles with Sealaska, carrying their experience forward into the organization. Leadership in our community already exists and prioritizing shareholder hire makes space for our People to contribute and guide our future.

# PHOTO & RECORDING POLICY

---

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) sponsors biennial Celebrations and other events for the cultural enrichment and enjoyment of Tlingit, Haida, and Tsimshian and to promote cultural diversity and cross-cultural understanding. Photographers, filmmakers and other recorders attend SHI events hoping to document regalia, dances, and Native people. Many dancers wear Native regalia with clan crests, perform dances and present clan objects that are proprietary and historic. Under Native traditional law, clans own crests, stories, songs, names, and much of the regalia and crests are protected by copyright. SHI adopts this policy to protect the clan ownership of their intellectual property and limit commercialization of Celebration and SHI sponsored activities, while permitting appropriate photography and other recordings:

## Protocols

Photography and recording is permitted only in public performance areas, and photographers shall not interfere with any participant's enjoyment of Celebration. Flash photography, use of props, disturbing or seeking to pose performers, rearranging backdrops, getting on stage, and changing of lighting are expressly prohibited. Courtesy requires obtaining permission from an individual (not group) subject before taking his or her picture or recording them. Drones are prohibited inside and on the exterior of any of the venues SHI uses for Celebration, including, but not limited to, Centennial Hall, Elizabeth Peratrovich Hall, the Sealaska Heritage Arts Campus and in the airspace over its adjacent plaza, and Sealaska Plaza. People flying drones in public spaces near or at Celebration events, such as the parade and grand entrance, must have any and all required licenses and permissions from appropriate government entities to do so.

## News media photography

Any individual, organization or company wishing to engage in still photography, audio recording, videotaping or filming for broadcast or public news dissemination by any means on or in property used for SHI Celebrations must obtain permission by registering in advance with an appropriate SHI official. By registering, news agencies agree not to reproduce their work in any forum other than print or broadcast news, and further agree not to sell their work for any non-news use. Recordings are to be used only for news coverage of Celebration. Only excerpts of twenty seconds or less of songs may be used for news coverage. Broadcast or use of songs in their entirety is prohibited without written permission from clans that own the songs.

## Personal-use photography

Personal-use photography is allowed. Non-tribal members who want to photograph or record Celebration for personal use must register. Tribal members do not have to register. SHI will assist the owners in enforcing their copyright in the event any personal-use photograph or recording is sold.

## Documentarians & bloggers

Any individual, organization or company wishing to engage in still photography, audio recording, videotaping or filming for documentaries or blogs by any means on or in property used for SHI Celebrations must obtain permission by submitting a request to SHI's media department at least three months prior to Celebration. SHI will evaluate requests by documentarians and bloggers to document Celebration on a case-by-case basis. Any use of Celebration photos or recordings in projects must be in line with SHI's mission to perpetuate and enhance Tlingit, Haida and Tsimshian cultures and its goals to promote cultural diversity and cross-cultural understanding. Documentarians and bloggers shall be required to prominently credit SHI for allowing use of the materials. If SHI grants such a request, the requestor must complete a license agreement furnished by SHI and abide by all terms therein. By signing the agreement, documentarians and bloggers agree not to reproduce their work in any forum other than the project identified in the agreement and further agree not to sell their work for any other use. Only excerpts of twenty seconds or less of songs may be used for projects. Use of songs in longer excerpts or their entirety is prohibited without written permission from clans that own the songs.

## Commercial photography

Commercial photography, recording, video-taping or filming of any kind is expressly prohibited. SHI reserves the right to eject any person it believes is taking photographs or recordings for commercial purposes at Celebration or violating protocols noted above. SHI will help enforce copyright in the event any news media photograph, audio recording or footage is sold.

## Registration

Those visitors or media personnel wishing to take photographs of any kind need to register at the photography table where you will be issued a pass allowing you to take photographs. Those persons taking pictures or recordings without a pass will be asked to leave. Tribal members taking photographs for personal use are not required to register.
