OVERVIEW OF TASK/WORK

Sealaska Heritage Institute (SHI) is seeking a Haida artist to create Haida alphabet cards to be used in Baby Raven Reads programming as well as shared with our partners and early childhood educators.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Design a cover for the set of Haida Alphabet sound cards.
2. Design 43 (forty-three) Haida Alphabet Sound Cards
3. Each card will highlight a different sound, with an appropriate graphically designed image to accompany it.
4. Each image will be square ratio and no less than 300 dpi.
5. Each image will reflect Haida culture and be age appropriate for birth to five-year-olds.

REQUIRED SKILLS

- Excellent graphic design skills
- Ability to work well on own initiative and within a team
- Ability to take constructive feedback and make necessary changes
- Follow predetermined design guidelines
